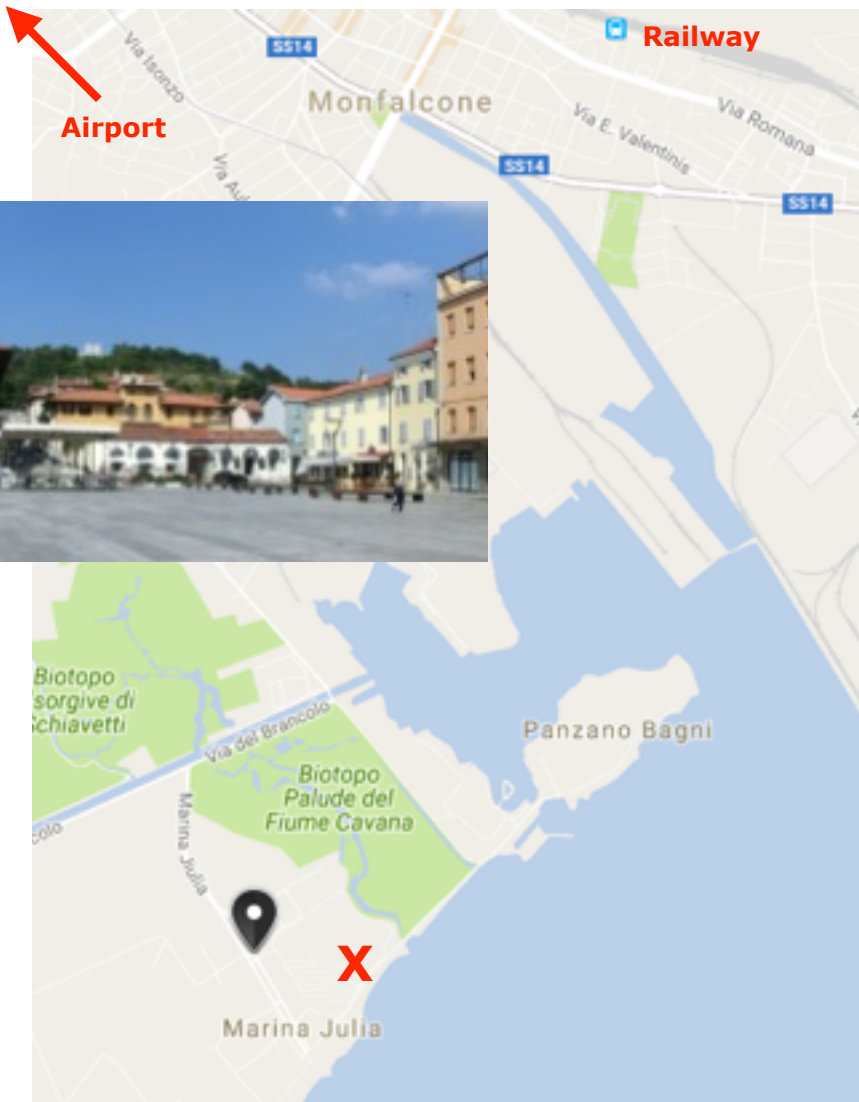

Monfalcone and Marina Julia



Monfalcone is an industrial town 30 km northwest of Trieste, with <30,000 inhabitants, 18% of which immigrants. Mainly maritime industry; the biggest cruisers are built here.

The seaside is not Rimini, but has its *charme discret*, less tourism, more nature.

Marina Julia is a small quarter out of town, next to the Adriatic, surrounded by green areas, with 2 groceries, 1 baker, 1 kiosk and 2 bars; 4 more bars are to be found along the beach (pebbles and sand).

How to get here

By train: The fast train Milano-Trieste stops in Monfalcone. From there, the bus takes you to Marina Julia (or taxi, or walk 5 km).

By plane: The Trieste airport (TRS) is 9 km from Marina Julia, bus or taxi. Cheaper flights to Venice Marco Polo (VCE) or Venice Treviso (TSF), from there take the train to Monfalcone.

Applications for speech or poster

- We accept drafts on **subjects pointed out on page 1**. (Should you want to bring up another subject, please have our consent first.)
- Please present your draft of **300 words max** before **31 May**, indicating speech or poster. By applying for a speech you accept that the organising committee can assign you poster place instead, given the limit of 12 speeches in total.
- We will inform you on our decision by 15 June. The final version of your presentation or of the abstract of your poster must reach us before **15 August** to give us the time for preparing the books of all scripts for each participant.

In order to profit from the outdoor opportunities, we free ourselves from technical bonds. **There will be no microphone, no beamer, no screen, and no pin boards.** Just chairs in concentric circles and scripts. Therefore:

- **Presentations** consist of text (not smaller than Verdana 11 point), graphs and photos, 10 page max. Paper format: A4. Left margin must be 30 mm (for punched holes). Right margin must be at least 50 mm (for notes)
- **Poster abstracts:** 1 page (instead of an abstract, a copy of the poster can do as well). Paper format: A4. Left margin must be 30 mm (for punched holes).
- Design **posters** for display on table/ground, font size at least 76 point in the end.

Participation

Participation is **limited** to about 40 persons lodging plus some local participants. **Priority** is given to persons presenting speech or poster.

Lodging and meals

We will occupy a part of the resort «Villaggio turistico Albatros» next to the beach. You will stay in a bungalow, in a separate room, but sharing the bathroom with a second person.

You will get breakfast, lunch and dinner in the resorts' restaurant (you have the choice between vegan or not).

Participation costs: EUR 237,00*

- EUR 87,00 Lodging, 3 nights, single room (only 2 persons share 1 bungalow)
EUR 72,00 Lodging 3 nights when 3 persons share 1 bungalow)**
EUR 54,00 Lodging 3 nights when 4 persons share 1 bungalow)**
- EUR 60,00 all meals (3 times breakfast, lunch, 3 dinner)
- EUR 90,00 registration fee to cover organisational costs***

* Fixed prices, there will be no discount in case of part-time participation

** bungalows for 3 or 4 persons to be booked only on the whole by groups of 3 to 4

*** Persons with low income who present speech or poster may ask for exemption
